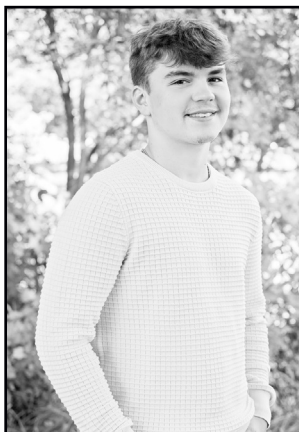
Tayden Hicks
